1.5. Partnership

1.5.1. Composition of the Partnership

Partnership is created by Slovak and Ukrainian partners: Košice Self-governing Region, Transcarpathian Regional Centre for Social and Labour Rehabilitation and Professional Orientation "Vybir" and Department for international cooperation and innovations of of Uzhhorod City Council.

Košice Self-governing Region (KSR) (SK) is set up by an act No. 302/2001 Coll.. Its aim in the field of social affairs is to coordinate, secure and finance social services. KSR is the founder of 13 social services facilities but it also supports more than 250 social services facilities of private ownership. Social services facilities founded by KSR will also participate in the activities of the project. KSR already has experiences with similar projects, such as project "KVApka – Quality for facilities in the jurisdiction of the Košice self-governing region". Transcarpathian Regional Centre for Social and Labour Rehabilitation and Professional Orientation "Vybir" is a non-governmental organisation providing social services in Trancarpathian region.

Department for international cooperation and innovations of of Uzhhorod City Council realises its competences in social area through supporting and financing the social organizations of various forms of ownership, including public and charitable organizations. The most active organizations in the city are: Uzhgorod City Territorial Center of Social Services "Providing Social

Services", Medical Social Rehabilitation Center "Path of Life", Charitable Fund "Vse Mozhlyvo", Charitable Fund "Caritas", NGO "Happy Kids", and Association of Protection of Persons with Disabilities "Hope". All organizations care about the health of people with disabilities, including children and families with children with disabilities as well as elderly people and people without a residence.

1.5.2. Arrangements among Partners / beneficiaries

The arrangements in the partnership of the three applicants are settled according to their expertise and experiences to ensure successful implementation of the entire project. The project partnership will be represented by Košice Self-governing Region (KSR) as Lead Applicant. KSR has many experiences with leadership in different regional and transnational projects, also with successful projects in the area of social care. KSR will be responsible for the overall project management including the coordination of project partners. All partners' terms and conditions, responsibilities and duties will be stated in the Partnership Agreement among applicants and Lead Applicant. The partnership agreement

2. Project Description

2.1. Overall objective of the Project

Overall project objective is to improve the health of social care services facilities' clients in Kosice Region and in Transcarpathia.

The clients of social services facilities in both regions are very often not only mentally disabled but also physically disabled people. Clients who are served and/or live in these places usually suffer from serious or incurable diseases, in particular, clients with Parkinson's disease, Alzheimer's disease, pervasive developmental disorder, multiple MS, schizophrenia, dementia of a different type of aetiology, AIDS, deaf blindness, autism, child's cerebral palsy etc. In addition, the attention is also paid to the people who are prone to certain diseases, from children to the elderly people, especially people with disabilities. The staff of the facilities help them with various therapies and activities to improve their health and thus ensure them better life. The project contributes to the overall programme goal as well as to programme specific objective.

2.2. Please describe the specific objectives of your project

The specific objectives of the project are the following:

- 1. Improve skills and knowledge of social care services facilities' staff. Providing social services including nursing care is very demanding and requires monitoring of new and innovative approaches and trends in the area in order to provide care of a good quality for the seriously ill person. To improve health we need to achieve full or partial recovery of the functions, lost due to illness or injury, through the use of manual therapy, physical and psychological rehabilitation, exercise, physical, electrotherapeutic and mechanical means, and movement exercises. In order to improve the skills and knowledge of the staff training activities and study visits will be carried out.
- 2. Create better conditions for activities and therapies in social care services facilities.

The number of immobile clients and clients with morbid obesity is increasing. Treatment and care of such clients is physically demanding. Appropriate equipment would reduce the demands for physical staffing. Especially in Transcarpathia region social facilities do not have enough of the necessary material and technical basis for the implementation of quality services in the sphere of health care, rehabilitation, provision of basic needs and supporting the health of clients. Therefore upgrading of material and technical basis of social facilities will help to reach a higher level of quality in providing social and medical services and it will also reduce the workload

Uzhhorod are responsible for operating of social services facilities and for their financing as well. Both partners systematically support facilities in enhancing the quality of their services including staff capacity building.

They are responsible for operating of social services in their territories. Košice Region is obliged to provide social care services for different target groups. This obligation is fulfilled by the network of 13 social service facilities, as well as by the financial support of some other private social care providers in this region. The city of Uzhhorod cares about people with special needs, through the work of social organizations of various forms of ownership, including public and charitable organizations

Funds for the purchase of equipment and organising trainings are not allocated. Today attention is not properly paid to the personnel of social services facilities in terms of their learning and mastering the latest trends in working with clients. As nursing care is very demanding and requires monitoring of new and innovative approaches and trends and exchange of experience in this area to reach a higher level of quality in providing care for the seriously ill person, one of the project aim is to improve skills and knowledge of the employees of social care facilities by training activities and exchange of experience through study visits. The project will help to gain new knowledge and implement it in practice in UA side with the support of the Slovak experts, which in turn will result in highly qualified services for clients. The second aim is to create better conditions for activities and therapies in social care services facilities by upgrading of material and technical basis of social facilities.

3.4. Project's approach in addressing the identified common problems and needs

There are common problems and needs at both sides of the border in the area of providing care at social services facilities. The most visible are insufficient education of the staff of facilities and insufficient material equipment. As there are new and innovative trends in working with clients, the training of the staff in new and innovative approaches will improve the level of quality in providing care for the seriously ill person. Exchange of experience through study visits of UA specialists in the facilities in Kosice region and tutoring them by SK experts at their home organisations will lead to highly qualified services for clients. The added value of the project will be better reputation of the social services facilities as they would offer services of better quality. The staff will have new and innovative approach to the clients and the facilities will be better equipped. Finally, the health of the clients of social services facilities will be improved through better care.

3.5. Cross-border cooperation approach in achieving the project's objectives and results The project objectives and results could not be efficiently reached acting only on a national/regional/local level as the social care services facilities on the UA side do not have enough personal and technical basis for the implementation of quality services in the sphere of health care. The attention is not properly paid to the personnel of social institutions in terms of their learning and mastering the latest trends in working with clients. The cross-border cooperation within the project will lead to achieving the project first specific objective: 1. to improve skills and knowledge of social care services facilities' staff by study visits of UA staff in Kosice region, training and tutoring of them by Slovak experts. The improved skills and knowledge will be implemented in practice in Ukraine with the support of the Slovak experts, which in turn will result in highly qualified services for clients. Upgrading of material and technical basis of social facilities on both sides of the borders will lead to achieving the second project specific objective: 2. create better

As the project main activities focuses on trainings and study visits, the environmental sustainability could be reached by using sustainable use of transport for travelling to Slovakia and Ukraine and not individual cars. Environmental aspects will be also applied when purchasing the equipment for social services facilities, if it will be relevant.
